2. School Improvement Plan and Trust Land Funds:

2020-21

- We will increase from 61% to 63% of students in grades K-6 will show “typical” (or higher) progress on Acadience Reading Pathways of Progress on middle of year Acadience assessments. ***\$21,000 will help reduce class sizes making learning more enhanced and students will receive more attention from teacher and tutors. \$28,000 will be spent on reading tutors to help increase student reading abilities. \$2,000 will be used to purchase mCLASS student licenses. \$5,500 will be used to update tutor and staff technology as they work with students in small groups to increase their reading abilities.***
- Build foundational knowledge and capacity for faculty and staff in the five CASEL competencies of self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decision making adults by creating a school SEL plan using the Davis School District's SEL Walkthrough Tool. ***No funding assigned for this goal.***
